SOUND EFFECTS: Simon says - We deeply regret the absence of the Prime Minister and the cause of it. After the Armistice, nations were still bleeding from the scourge of four years of war, "talks about reduction of Naval armaments the only way being thru' international agreement. Cecil says "We urge that there shall be no more ships built over 10,000 tons. We hold that Naval Monsters larger than that have no real reason for their existance except to fight one another. Next we abolish subs and you would say 25% on World expenditure.
