News Cameraman, asks Shaw to face camera) It is very difficult for me to know exactly where my audience is (Ben Hart moves Bernard Shaw) (Ben Hart says, "Put your face that way)" Now Gentlemen (Laughter from audience) tells me to face this way (Laughter) because these Gentlemen who are operating (Laughter) of course they go to the wrong side, they always do. (Laughter)</p> <p>Semi cu Shaw talking : Shakespeare had a Mulberry tree and I am not going to be outdone by Shakespeare (Laughter). I er—the attraction is that it last so long. I er, I can't last for ever, (Laughter from crowd somebody yells out "Shame". You heard that expression of relief (Laughter)</p> <p>Cu. of <u>Bernard Shaw</u> talking — And I now, I am now going to plant the <u>Mulberry Tree</u>, (Laughter) I am in a certain difficulty about it (Back to camera) because it is perfectly obvious to all of you that it is already planted.
