SV. Hallo everybody, it's good to be back in dear old London. My mission round the world, last of all to Herr Hitler, was on behalf of peace. The masses in all lands want peace. They know war means ruin for all. They support the proposal for a peace conference before war breaks out. Hitler has said Germany will join such a conference.

SV. (offstage) Is this the first time you have met Herr Hitler, Mr. Lansbury?

(Lansbury) The first and only time.

(offstage) People are often saying Hitler wants war. What do you think? (Lansbury) I think that no statesman in the world wants war. All of them claim that they are arming for defence, and therefore all of them ought to come together and agree that defence is best reached by disarmament.

(Offstage) I believ- see it has been said, or rather, suggested, in certain quarters, that you have become a Fascist (laugh laughter). What about that?

(Lansbury) That's all rubbish. ^{have} How could I/become a Fascist? Herr Hitler knows that I am a Socialist, a democrat. He also knows that I am a pacifist, and have been a pacifist all my life. Everybody in the world knows that I gave up my seat in Parliament, ~~and~~ gave up my leadership--er, gave up my leadership of the Labour Party in Parliament because I stood for pacifist (stumble) pacifism pure and simple. How could I go over to Fascism, - too ludicrous for words, too absurd to be argued about. (offstage) Well, here's the best of luck to your peace campaign, anyway, Mr. Lansbury. The peace campaign's going strong. I have not met a man or a woman, and I have met hundreds of them during this trip, of all nations, and everyone of them has wished me good luck, has wished the peace movement good luck, and all of them want peace because, as I say, they know war is hell, and brings destruction, and no victor or vanquished.
