**COPY of Cameraman's Depe Sheet on interview with Sergt. Hannah, V.C.,
and Pilot Officer Conner, D.F.C.**

Sergt. Hannah, 18 year old Scotsman, who is-top rear gunner and wireless operator, won the V.C. for extinguishing a fire in a Hampden Bomber while under intense A.A.fire. Pilot Officer Conner, a Canadian, received the immediate award of the D.F.C. for maintaining control of the machine and flying it safely back to its base.
