Pilot C.A.H. Connor talking

① [WE were over Antwerp when we were hit by a large shell. It burst in the bomb compartment and made a very large hole] I could see we were in danger when the flames were reflected in my wind-~~screen~~ screen. I sat up here and the flames were getting very close to the back of my neck.

LV Pilot and Hannah talking:

[Almost at the same time Sergeant Hannah called me on the inter-communication and said 'I told my Captain that the aircraft was on fire' He asked me if it was very bad. Well I had a look around, to find it's bad and not too bad.] This reassured me and I thought Sergeant Hannah would be able to cope with it.]

"Tell them Sergeant how you managed to avoid being suffocated."

SCU Sergeant Hannah talking:

"First I put my oxygen mask on but the fumes were too strong for it and I had ~~great~~ very difficult ~~to~~ er - to breath. So eventually I took it off and I was into the upper cockpit and opened the turrets and swung my guns around, came up for some air. I did this two or three times. Pilot talking : It was there that the fire was fiercest. [Thousands of rounds of ammunition were exploding all over the place and it's a wonder to me how Sergeant Hannah managed to be missed by it.]"

SV Hannah talking:

[Well Sir, I have not yet stopped wondering how you missed them, most of them seemed to be going in your direction.

O'Connor: I was too busy taking evasive action against the heavy stuff to notice the smaller stuff much. Well I noticed them Sir and glad they missed you ^{otherwise} ~~neither~~ ^{Hannah} of us would be here now. ^{an}

CU Pilot talking:

I was too busy taking evasive action against the AA fire seeing up to pay much attention to that. Pan to Hannah: OH I noticed them sir otherwise neither of us would be here now.
