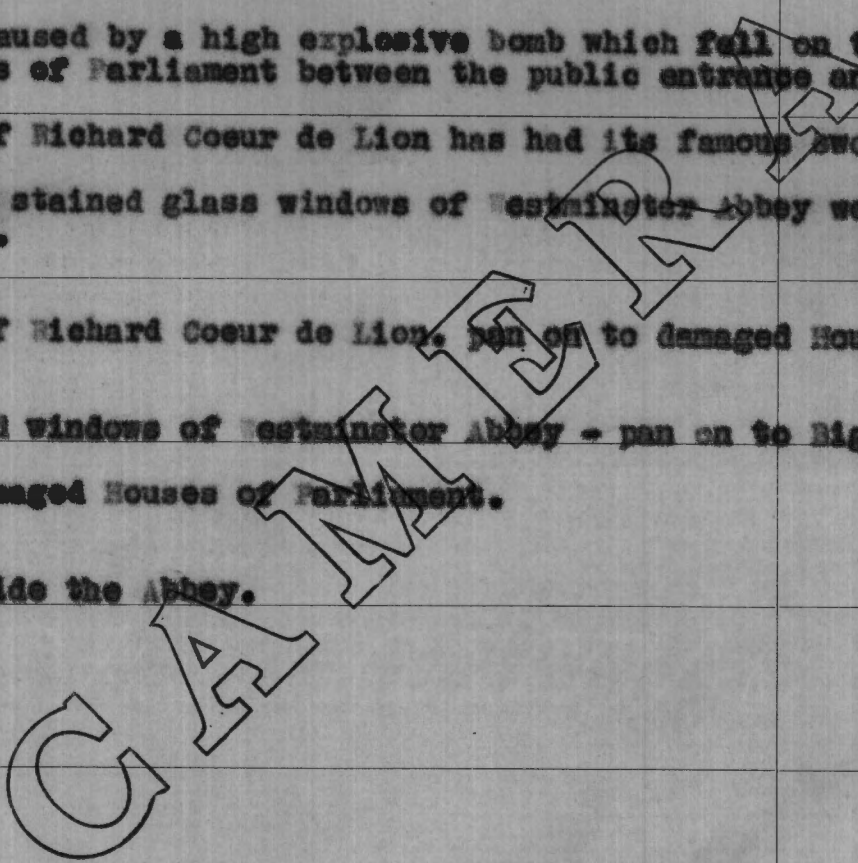

1.	Once again St. Pauls has been bombed but this time Wrens fine work was actually damaged and yet stood up to the Hun terrorism wonderfully well. A hole <del>in</del> in the roof high above the High Altar shows where the bomb entered and the High Altar itself is a complete wreck. Actually the only real loss beside the Altar itself was a old candlestick and a famous cross.				
2.	This is the Second time the Cathedral has missed being destroyed. Canon Alexander considered that Wrens work was amazing and outstanding to be able to defy the German bombs.

3.	Various scenes inside the Cathedral of the damage. Scenes showing the Bishops chair slung by the blast of the bomb across the knave of the church up against the rails.				
4.	Scenes of the smashed masonry Various scenes of the actual hole in the roof and still the same old London skyline stands intact! You have plenty of scenes in the <del>library</del> library of the exterior of St Pauls so I did not waste film on reshooting it.
