A show is given by the Foreign Legion on board the ship.. The General and General Spirs. Arrival at Freetown (Sierra Leone). The ^{convoy} ~~'Force'~~ arrives at Freetown. The ~~convoy~~ leaves Freetown for Dakar.

Early in the morning on the 23rd of September, the Parliamentary? (Cpts. Dargendien, chief of them) leaves the Sa^{NAN} ~~Vorgnan~~ de Brazza ^{which} is just in the entrance of Dakar harbour. There is also ^{two} a motor boat,

The parliamentary leaving the Sa~~V~~orgnan de Brazza, that has orders to wait for them. Suddenly we can see the guns of Dakar firing on us. Shells falling near the boat and we can hear the machine-guns firing. We do not fire.

We are obliged to move back because of the bombing. Suddenly we can see two motor boats coming toward us full speed. It is the parliamentary. Few are wounded (Cpt ^{DARGENDIEN} ~~Saragendien~~ and Cpt. Derrin). We take them on board and we move back full speed with the motor boats near us. The Sa~~V~~orgnan de Brazza has the order to go and land troops at Dufisque.

The Brazza and ^{two} ~~two~~ French "Arisot" (^{little} ~~---~~ Destroyers) ^{Commandant} ~~Domine~~ and Duboc ^{Commandant} arrive at nightfall. The enemy opens fire and gets a direct hit on the Duboc. Shells falling all over us. The Duboc moves back and the Brazza trys to land troops on the beach. Machine guns firing everywhere. We just fire a few shells on 7.5 guns and get out troops on board again because we do not want to kill French people.
