Runners were sent by Abyssinian chiefs to the headquarters of the ex-Emperor Haile Selassie, who is making a bid to liberate his country. Abyssinia has never been effectively conquered; outside the towns the natives defy the Italians, despite the huge garrison. These are exclusive British Paramount News pictures.

The runners brought messages in which the chieftains affirmed their loyalty to the former Emperor and declared they will rally to him when he returns - an avowal which rewards the patience and dignity with which Haile Selassie has born his cruel fate.

The ex-Emperor's reply was printed in a leaflet which airplanes dropped over Abyssinian country. Already the chiefs are harrasing the Italians; if they rebel in a big way the garrison will be hard put to it. Cut off from Italy except by air, they largeley depend on accumulated stores, which can be burned.
