1. Mr. Eden arrives by plane to visit advanced desert stations accompanied by Gen. Wilson, C. in C. British Troops in Egypt and Gen. O'Connor, C. in C. in the field.
2. Mr. Eden visits New Zealand contingent dispersed in small groups in case of sudden air attack.
3. Mr. Eden visits defence posts and has sector defence explained. He visits one of the desert dugouts.
4. Mr. Eden visits a small unit of Australians; while there a lorry load of Free French troops stop by, and Mr. Eden speaks to them and pats their white-haired mascot.
5. The Polish troops give an impressive march past. On their own initiative they lay out a small military review. Col. Kopanski commands them. On dais with Mr. Eden is Gen. Sir Henry Wilson, C. in C. British Troops in Egypt. These men in most cases escaped from Poland by various routes to Syria and later came over to us in Palestine.
6. Group of Mr. Eden, Gen. Wavell and Air Vice Marshal Drummond. Mr. Eden coming through a line of nurses after visiting New Zealand hospital
7. Men setting off on route march
8. Gv. men setting off on route march - angles and closeups.
9. To finish up roll, shot small fire in ruin.
