1.	Seventy-one tube stations are being supplied with food for the inhabitants that shelter there at night-time. The number sheltering is estimated to be 120,000 people.				
2.	Forty-eight canteens have been erected at present to accommodate these people, but in the near future there will be 100. A quarter of a million people drink throughout the night tea or cocoa cups of cocoa and tea are drunk throughout the night.				
3.	The menu consists of buns, cake, chocolate; meat pies and sausages are being introduced in the near future. Six depots have been established for supplying these tube stations with food, employing a thousand people to cope with this new problem. Within a month of the Board being requested by the Ministry of Food to undertake this scheme, 50% of the canteens and organization is in working order.				
4.	The foodtrains work in between the normal running service without any delay. The foodtrains are allowed 20 seconds to unload their bins of food and continue to the next station.
