Buckingham Palace was the destination of 27 mobile canteens. They were part of the fleet of 48 that the Trade Union movement has presented to the Y.M.C.A. for use with his Majesty's forces. His Majesty himself had promised to inspect them.

Most of the canteens were given by individual unions. The Seamen presented this one. Four were the gift of the General Council of the T.U.C., whose members were greeted by the King and Queen. Their Majesties were told how the funds had been raised in the workshops all over the country. Besides 1000 mobile canteens at home, there are 600 abroad, from Iceland to Egypt. Mr. George Gibson, General Council chairman, gave the T.U.C. gold badge to the King, and told him he may now visit the Congress whenever he likes.
