Northern Ireland accorded a state funeral to Lord Craigavon. His daughter, Mrs. Linzee, and two of his brothers were among family mourners at Belmont Church. The last tribute was paid to an old friend by Lord and Lady Londonderry. The Governor-General, the Duke of Abercorn, represented the King.

On a simple gun-carriage the coffin was taken to Stormont, seat of the Government of which Lord Craigavon was Prime Minister since it was founded in 1921.

Right-hand-man of Lord Carson, Craigavon governed at Stormont for nearly twenty years. He was laid to rest in sight of the parliament buildings.
