Shots of Officers etc. of Destroyer FURY on bridge

First shots of H.M.S. KELLY at dawn (after being torpedoed)

H.M.S. KELLY listing badly is taken into tow by BULLDOG

Shots of KELLY being towed across the sea

Survivors from KELLY are taken off in boats from Destroyers
during air bombing attack by Heinkels.

"Hudson" aircraft chases German Bomber into a cloud from
distance

Bombs dropping and bursting around KELLY and destroyers
taken as they actually exploded but through mist of our
spray.

Boats with survivors being hoisted on Destroyers Davits men
lined along deck hauling on the ropes for above shot showing
hole in side of KELLY where torpedo struck.

Shot of KELLY'S Commander (Captain Lord Louis Mountbatten)
with men who volunteered to remain on ship, on quarter-deck

Bomb bursts in our wake as we, FURY, zigzagged at speed.

Triumphal entry into harbour, sailors on fore-castle of FURY
cheer their comrades on the salvaged KELLY

Various shots taken on KELLY in the repair yards, showing some
of the damage caused by the explosion. Shot from small
boat showing KELLY with huge crane and pumping pontoons
alongside. Torpedo tubes being lifted by crane.

Pumps at work, pumping out flooded compartments, shots of
KELLY'S heroic captain talking to Admiralty Official who
designed the ship
