But why make it all worse by keeping the shelter uncomfortable? You'll find in your letter-box a small booklet explaining how to make an Anderson shelter like a luxury flat.

Wooden bunks can be quite easily made, and fitted so that six people can sleep with room for all. Cover the frame with wire mesh, which you can buy in plenty, and note how to bend the wires, at right-angles... ^{just} Hammer them into the wood. No nails or staples are wanted, ^{But be sure to} hammer them straight.

This is how the six bunks fit in. For your own covering, sleeping bags are best. ^{Be sure to have a} mattress underneath.

Don't have an oil stove or brazier in the shelter. A candle ^{inside} and two flower pots will give all the heat you want.

Tea will keep hot ~~for~~ all night in a hay bottle. The booklet tells how to make one with some wollen materials, a little straw and some American Cloth.

Always wrap up well for the shelter, otherwise you'll soon be stone cold. Take your money with you and any important papers. Something to eat and drink before going to sleep, and the Nazis can do what they like.

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The all-clear! Just about getting up time, too. Thanks to taking the advice in the booklet they've had a real night's sleep.
