Various shots of soldiers marching past and c.u. soldiers.

Horses and mules and anti-aircraft guns used in this mountainous country. The cavalry canter by.

Story could have been much better despite restrictions but camera has behaved badly since it was blown up and smothered in salt water. Had 4 jams in five boxes. Found a camera mechanic and we stripped it again so will test it on Parliament opening. Had it down before and tested it and it was O'Kay; can only hope this time it really is.
