GORDON SPEAKS:

SV "Let us make up our minds now, before we have to face the problem, ^{for ourselves} that what happened to ~~so~~ many of the fine men who fought to save us 25 years ago is ^{not} going to happen to the great boys who are saving us to-day. ^(heated)
