1.	The first real London Blitz this year occurred last night during a complete blackout. Planes flew up the Thames towards London and dropped their load of incendiaries together with H.E. and land mines.				
2.	I saw two and maybe three landmines in the air at one time, but the fire was not high enough to give them light although I had a shot at them.				
3.	A.F.S. man saved the fire from spreading, and many were killed. Some were thrown into the river from their perches where they were playing on the fires, others were crashed beneath heavy walls which fell through the heat of the fires.				
4.	I should estimate a dozen firemen dead, the injured were too far away from the light of the fire to get an exposure and the smoke completely hid some of the fires. The mines and bombs flying bricks and rubbish together with sparks of the fires, all over the place, incendiaries danced in the river but again the smoke obliterated their finite value completely. A blitz of the worst type.
