ATTACK BY ENEMY DIVE-BOMBERS ON WESTERN MEDITERRANEAN SQUADRON.

Box. 1. Convoy proceeding through Mediterranean is attacked by enemy bombers. Pictures show convoy before and during attack, accompanying ships firing, aircraft should be distinguishable amongst shell-bursts. Usual load of bombs drop close to ARK ROYAL.

ARK ROYAL steams on unperturbed with guns still firing. RENOWN'S 4.5's and pom-poms in action throughout.

Box. 2. Shots of ARK ROYAL. Convoy proceeding. Fulmars help to ward off attack. Build-up. Air defence look-outs spot planes and orders are given to open fire. Air Defence Officer is wearing tin hat marked "A D O" and should come in immediately before seaman wearing headphones who passes order on. Captain of RENOWN (flagship) R.R. McGregor on bridge throughout. Signalmen in flagship.

GREEK NAVY JOINS ALLIED FLEET IN MEDITERRANEAN PORT.

Following on the German occupation of Greece, ships of the Royal Hellenic Navy safely reach a Mediterranean Port.

In these pictures are seen shots of Greek destroyers at anchor, and scenes taken aboard the "AVEROFF", flagship of the Greek Navy.

These ships, during the time that Greece has been at War, have achieved notable successes against Italian submarines.

The cruiser "AVEROFF" seen here is an Italian-built ship, built in 1910, and after the cowardly sinking by an Italian submarine before Greece had even entered the war, of the cruiser "HELLAS", is the only large ship which the Greeks possess, apart from several modern destroyers.

(Disregard second shot on Roll 1 which is of the French battleship "LORRAINE".)

An inspection aboard the "AVEROFF" is carried out by H.R.H. Prince Paul of Greece. Other shots show Greek sailors manning anti-aircraft guns and Greek sailors on Guard duty. Shot of Captain Vlachapoulof, captain of the "AVEROFF", and a shot of Prince Paul with officers of the ship on the quarterdeck.

It is anticipated that these Greek ships will be able to do useful work in co-operation with the Mediterranean Fleet.
