NEGUS REVIEWS TROOPS

Shortly after Haile Selassie was returned to his throne after six years in exile, troops who had always been loyal and who did a considerable amount of fighting themselves, marched past the Emperor outside his Palace in Addis Ababa.

The men are those of Ras Abeba Asagai (?) who is recognised as a great fighter. His young son is starting soon too.

Each sub-chief, as his men go by the Emperor, runs forward and calls out in a loud voice the feats he and his men have performed. In doing so they almost go into hysterics. Rain steps play!

Seated with the Emperor are his two sons wearing uniform of the Ethiopian Army, and other officials.
