## Attack on Wood Street Building.

Object. The object of the exercise is to provide training in street fighting and guarding of the telephone exchange against attack by enemy parachute troops under conditions similar to whose which would be experienced during an actual attack.

## Home Guards Taking Part.

The attacking troops are being provided by the 16th C.O.L. (L.M.S) Battalion Rome Guard whose Battalion strength is approximately 2,600. The number of attacking troops will be 350, under the command of Major Rupert Amern.

The defence of the Building is in the hands of the 20th City of London (3rd G.P.O) Battalion Home Guard will have 200 men under the control of Major Haynes D.C.M., M.M. The strength of this Battalion is 1,600.

## Operation Areas.

The enemy troops will assemble on the boundaries of the Area and the defending troops will assemble in Wood St. Building. No entry will be made into the Area by either side until zero hour at 10:00 a.m. At this time the enemy troops will commence operations by attacking through the streets and the defending troops will put out defensive patrols round the Wood St. Building. From these points they will send out the scouting, reconnaissing and fighting patrols to obtain information as to the direction in which the enemy is approaching the building and where his attack is likely to develope and the fighting patrols will be engaged in holding up his advance where possible. The enemy is expected to attack Wood St. Building from all sides with the use of gas, smoke and grenade. The road blocks will be built at stratogical points and covered by rifle fire. The building will be defended by posts manned by the Home Guard unit normally responsible for the defence of the building and it is to be held to the last man.

Operations will cease at 12.30 hours and all men taking part int. the operations will disperse.

Dress. In order to distinguish between the attacking and defending parties it has been arranged that the enemy will wear steel helmets and the defending forces field service caps.
