Assignment. - Fall of DAMASCUS.

1. Indian Troops in Bren Carriers approaching DAMASCUS.
2. Ditto passing through Barriocade and past Damascus railway signal box.
3. British Imperial and Free French forces enter DAMASCUS.
4. Crowds of citizens line the streets to welcome them, as they come through the town.
5. Crowd shots, including veiled Syrian women.
6. Free French transport with free French flags flying.
7. Vichy guns captured by the free French passing through.
8. Two British troops surrounded by happy waying people of DAMASCUS.
9. Free French Cyrassians cavalry. Also back shot showing lighted tramcar (evening) carrying on as usual.
10. Free French cavalry assembly outside DAMASCUS railway station to form guard of honour, for the official entry of GEN. CATROUX.
11. Various shots of GEN. CATROUX (in topee) with GEN. LEGENTILHOMME (with his arm in sling) in the procession through the town to the Government house.
12. General view of DAMASCUS. Two natives in foreground. (PEACE OVER DAMASCUS.).
