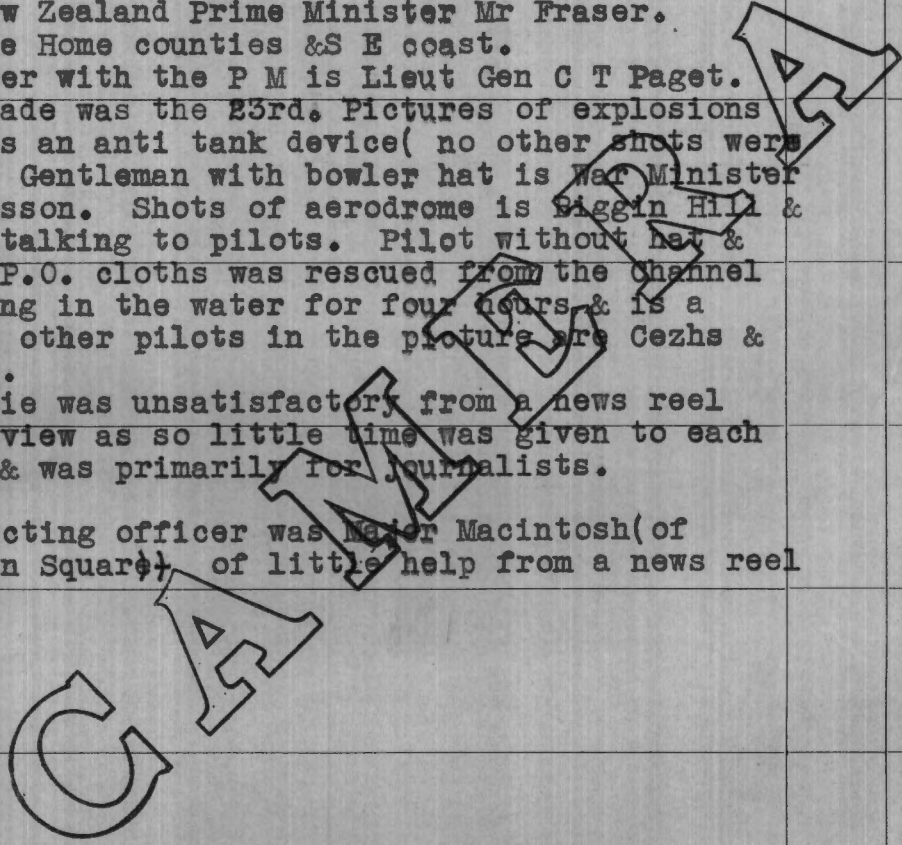

Pictures of mines exploding in road are anti-tank devices. (no other shots of this device was allowed).

Inspection of pilots at Biggin Hill. Close-up of one in Naval uniform was brought down the day before in channel and rescued after four hours in the sea. Picture of gentlemen welcoming Mr. Fraser is the War Minister Mr. Marguesson and group of Staff Officers.
