ADMIRAL SOMERVILLE'S FORCES TAKE ANOTHER CONVOY THROUGH IN SPITE OF SEVERE ENEMY AIR ATTACKS.

- Box 1.
1. Part of escorting forces - destroyers and cruiser.
 2. Entering danger zone - Renown's paravanes are streamed.
 3. Sunderland flying boat reports to Flagship Renown.
 4. Convoy takes up position under cover of Renown's 15" guns.

- Box 2.
1. Convoy is attacked by both high level and torpedo bombers. During action enemy planes should be clearly seen making low level attacks in face of intense barrage. Convoy carries on, but it is a grim business and we cannot expect to get away without loss. Destroyer "Fearless" was lost after valiant efforts to get fire under control. X

2. Good 17" shot of 'plane crashing into sea.
3. Nelson took part in the show and can be seen amongst convoy.

1. (CUTLINS) Signalmen kept busy throughout - A.A. gun crews - H.M.S. Nelson - Most attacks were beaten off by Ark Royal's fighters. Shots showing striking force leaving Ark Royal and returning after show. 17" shot of Italian cant in sea and crew being rescued by destroyer "Foresight".

- NELSON:** Various shots of Nelson and Ark Royal. These shots were taken during further attacks which were beaten off by Ark Royal's fighters. Further shots of Nelson for library and 17".
