Home Guard officers and NCOs at the Training School fall in for the early morning parade and march off.

Firing with weapons supplied from U.S.

- (1) The Browning Automatic Rifle.
- (2) The Browning Heavy Machine Gun.
- (3) The Thompson sub-machine Gun.

The Commandant (Lt.Col. H.Pollock) demonstrates that a shotgun, firing special ball, is a formidable firearm.

Throwing the A.W. Bomb (successor to the Molotov).

GRENADERS:

Priming the Mills with the ignition set.

Students in bombing pit with Training School Instructor throw live grenades.

- (1) No. 36. The well-known Mills Grenade.
Being fitted with a time fuse, there is a lapse of seconds before detonation.
- (2) No. 75. The "Thermos Flask" Grenade.
This acts on percussion and the sound is of a heavy explosion touched off quickly and rather unexpectedly.

The Instructors at the School then demonstrate the **STICKY BOMB**, which is shown in close-up being primed and prepared.

The Sticky is first of all thrown and explodes after lapse of few seconds.

The Commandant then slams another Sticky on a sheet of metal and jumps to safety.

NOTE: - As above stated, this is first release on the **STICKY BOMB** and **THERMOS FLASK-GRENADERS**. Press publicity is being timed to synchronise with release of this film on **THURSDAY, AUGUST 7th.**
