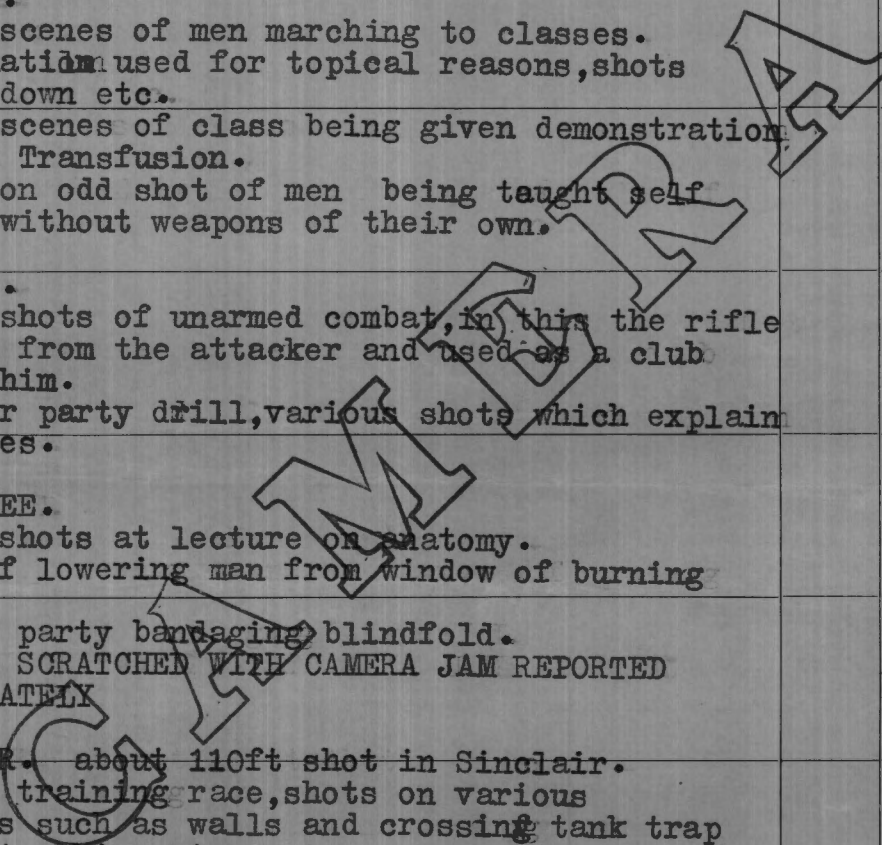

1.	ROLL ONE. Opening scenes of men marching to classes. "V" formation used for topical reasons, shots looking down etc.				
2.	Various scenes of class being given demonstration of Blood Transfusion. Run out on odd shot of men being taught self defence without weapons of their own.				
3.	ROLL TWO. Further shots of unarmed combat, in this the rifle is taken from the attacker and used as a club against him. Stretcher party drill, various shots which explain themselves.				
4.	ROLL THREE. Various shots at lecture on anatomy. Scenes of lowering man from window of burning room.				
5.	Stretcher party bandaging blindfold. PROBABLY SCRATCHED WITH CAMERA JAM REPORTED ON SEPARATELY				
6.	ROLL FOUR. about 110ft shot in Sinclair. Obstacle training race, shots on various obstacles such as walls and crossing tank trap without touching wire.				
7.	ROLL FIVE. 200ft shot in SINCLAIR. Attack scheme. Infantry advancing through smoke screen are followed by R.A.M.C., stretcher parties bring in wounded to field dressing station. Shots are long but can be cut about to get best effects.				
8.	Run out on crossing river with stretchers. Bearers undress and wrap clothes in ground sheets. The four bundles of the bearers are then placed in the water and the stretcher floated across the river on them.

General dope.

Men are trained ~~here~~ from raw recruits, they are given a comprehensive course in anatomy, first aid etc etc. Under modern warfare however they have to learn how to look after themselves so they are also given training in unarmed combat while they are kept fit by the usual p.t. and such things as obstacle climbing as shown. To wind up the story there is a scheme showing an infantry attack through smoke, the stretcher parties fetch in the wounded crossing a river with them and then take the men to a field dressing station.

Report on camera trouble.

After last trouble camera cleaned and polished etc. tests not showing any scratch. First two rolls today went O.K. watched gate aperture but could not see any scratch (scratch point is prior to aperture and so scratch is visible) After about 65 ft on roll three camera jammed, examination in change bag loosened it a bit but it stopped again, managed to get film through and then found large collection of emulsion on gate, presume that this caused the trouble. However borrowed a Sinclair to finish story with and am examining Eymo as soon as possible.
