The President would on no account allow sound.

The Prime Minister arrives at destroyer in launch. Mr. Churchill being piped aboard destroyer which took him to the PRINCE OF WALES and shaking hands with the captain.

The P.M. on bridge of destroyer. Meets Captain J.C. Leach. Premier aboard the PRINCE OF WALES; salutes quarter deck. Meets Captain J.C. Leach and the C-in-C Home Fleet, Admiral Sir J. Tovey..
