CLOSE UP: And both ~~her~~ her opening cruises have been freed altogether from monotony. On her cruiser you met the Bismarck and on your second met the illustrious President of the United States who is one of the men who ~~will~~ will take the greatest part in shaping the immediate future of our civilization. I feel that we have been blessed by good weather. We have had good weather just when we wanted it.

SEMI-VIEW Future has thus attended us. I am very grateful to ~~you~~ Captain Leach and all ranks and ratings who have done so much to make our voyage comfortable and pleasant and I am glad to have this opportunity of expressing my thanks. Many years ago there was a statesman who came back from a European conference who said he had brought with him peace with honour. We've not sought peace on this occasion and as for honour we've never lost it but we have brought back the means of raging more effective war and a surer hope of final and speedy victory. I think you will feel that you are taking part in these important events and that may be an interest to you when the full story has been made known and when the full story of this hard, stern war is told and I wish you the best of luck, the best of good comradeship, fine opportunities of winning fame and honour. And sure I am however the winds may blow that whatever may be the chances and accident of battle and the sea the men, the officers and men of the Prince of Wales will always be ready to add another page to the glorious and long annals of the Royal Navy.]
