JOE LOUIS: "As far as the Army is concerned I am ready to go any time Uncle Sam calls me."

BOB HOME SCU: "I I must admit I am a little nervous~~z~~ in front of a gathering like this because it is really a kick and my mother would love to have seen it because when I was just a boy she said that some day I might be President but I am satisfied with President Roosevelt and I think my children will be too (applause).
