The Germans in their retreat mined everything, even the vineyards. Sappers have cleared the ground, which was thickly sown with mines. At the crossing over the Kuban river and its tributaries, pontoon units worked relentlessly. Soldiers of the 44th. special pontoon battalion made use of a store of river-crossing transport which was captured from the enemy.

Artillery hurled its firepower against the German fortifications pounding the remnants of German troops retreating. Behind the wall of fire, the infantry advanced, supported by field artillery.

On the heights dominating the battlefield, photographers have set up their cameras to take a long distance view of the fighting. Through the camera's viewfinder can be seen a knocked out German tank....German tank soldiers are jumping out through the hatchway, and are being caught by our machine-gun fire. Enemy units retreat in disorder along the Taman road. Simultaneously, in the rear of the retreating enemy, fresh units appear across the marshes. An old Kuban fisherman, "Uncle Harenko", showed Capt. Vassanin's men the best place to cross, and helped them to get boats. Having disembarked, the soldiers went straight in to attack the Germans from the march.

- Here, in the S.W. part of the Taman Peninsula, the enemy suffered heavy casualties in fierce battles. German propaganda is dreadfully buzzing:- "Evacuation according to plan." The Red Army hurled the remnants of the German troops into the Kerch peninsula. Our artillery and airforce sank many enemy boats with thousands of soldiers and officers in the harbour of Taman. The Germans had no time to destroy the monument to the Zaporozhe Cossacks who landed here in the year 1792. On the monument is an inscription, partly worn away, which bids their descendants:- "Fight all infidels who may come to Taman!" Now the land of Taman is completely cleared of all the German Fascist Invaders.
