(1). Their Majesties arrive and are greeted by Major Gen. Doolittle, and thereafter introduced to Brig. Gen. Robert Williams, who commands one of the bombardment divisions, Col. Barlett Deaman, Col. Moore and Lt. Col. Hartman.

(2). Their Majesties inspect Guard of Honour.

(3). Their Majesties inspect a Liberator Air Crew, and in the 1st S.N. King is seen chatting to one of the crew captains, Capt. Hinchman of Ohio (pilot).

(4). Various shots of Queen, chatting to air crew members.

(5). Their Majesties entering and leaving a Flying Fortress, His Majesty helping the Queen on stepping out.
