CZECHS AND SOVIET SIGN AGREEMENT.

The Kremlin at Moscow was the scene of an event which may significantly affect post war Europe. President Kalinin and President Benes witnessed the signing of the Russo-Czech Pact. Benes was long refused permission to go to Russia, but at long last Ambassador Firlinger signed the pact on behalf of Czechoslovakia, and the presence of Marshal Stalin was proof that the treaty is of first class importance in Russian eyes. Foreign Commissar Molotov signed for U.S.S.R.

(Mol. finishes) Czechoslovakia will never again be ground between the millstones of power politics. Internationally as geographically she will be a link between Russia and the western world. The pact is another nail in the coffin of German imperialism.
