2.	Still photographers can get close and be satisfied with the close pictures and so not show the enormous press crowd around, whereas our coverage means long shots etc.				
3.	I would suggest that after the material be shown, you decide to cover training buildup which was impossible to be obtained today.				
4.	This coverage shows GENERAL EISENHOWER.....AIR CHIEF MARSHAL SIR ARTHUR TEDDER.....and GENERAL SIR BERNARD MONTGOMERY... going around the American Forces Training establishment.				
5.	The Generals inspected the British Forces training establishments the day previously.....this of course was not covered as we were not advised.				
6.	Scrappy coverage due to the rush of the Generals to the various locations.				
7.	Apart from the unfortunate difficulties which we faced, I must say that the American P.R.O. did their utmost to give us every help so that we may obtain the material.
