SUBJECT: UNITED STATES AND BRITISH FORCES TIGHTEN BORDER RESTRICTIONS ON EIRE.

In an effort to stop information leaks to enemy sources in independent Eire, American and British soldiers on the border of Northern Ireland and ~~and~~ Ulster and Eire start rigid inspection of credentials of all individuals crossing the frontier. All army personnel are restricted from an out of bounds area close to the border and also vehicles crossing are inspected by the constabulary of Northern Ireland. Trains to and from the two countries are carefully inspected by American and British M.P's.

1. Scene of a train pulling into a station en route from Dublin to Belfast.
2. Inspection is made of credentials of all passengers
3. Passengers boarding the train at this point are also asked to show Identification Cards. Woman Inspector is on hand when special inspection of women passengers are required.
4. The train pulls out as M.P's stand watch.
5. Constables on the highway to and from Dublin inspect all vehicles including buses cars and even travellers on bicycles.
6. An M.P. turns back American soldiers trying to get into the 'out of bounds' area.
7. Close-up of signs indicating 'Out of Bounds' area.
8. Scenes showing the need for extra caution along the border. Not far away is fairly large concentration of American equipment. Car and trucks waiting to be moved to areas where they ~~it~~ will be vitally needed.
9. Also in the nearby area are receiving points of vital war supplies such as planes etc.
10. Scenes showing shiploads of fighter planes arriving at Irish Port.
11. Unloading planes and towing away.
