Today, the G.O.C., Lt.-Gen. Sir Oliver Leese visited some of the men and Unit Commanders in his Army. In an Ordnance Field Park, a Corps Reinforcements unit, Base Supply Depot, a C.C.S. and an Advanced Ammunition Depot, he interrogated officers and men, asking shrew questions, bestowing praise, and distributing comforts. The General was obviously pleased with the competent efficiency of his troops, their air of confidence, and the warm welcome with which they received him.

NOTE: Owing to the cluster of officers who continually surrounded the General, the rapidity of his movements and a certain though perhaps unavoidable lack of co-operation, coverage of the subject lacks continuity.

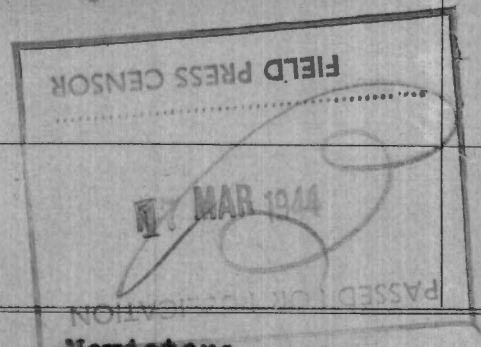
