VICTORIES IN SOUTH PACIFIC

General McArthur and Admiral Nimitz cook up another pot of hot water for the enemy. Navy pictures show them planning the campaign that brought final defeat to the Japs on Bougainville. Destroyers open the drive. Dive bombers blast the Japs -- so close that bursts are observed only a few yards from our forces. Robert S. Beightlers 57th Infantry girds for battle. These are the gallant troops that defended bloody Hill 700 against the infamous Jap Sixth... the enemy division that, earlier, was responsible for the shameful rape of Nanking. The enemy made a determined attempt to break through our lines and recapture our hard won air fields on Empress Augusta Bay. But, after four days of concentrated ground attack, the thirty seventh beats off the Japs. A Jap grenade rolls almost into our dressing stations. Each of our casualties was paid for manyfold by the enemy. Eight thousand Japs committed suicide in fanatical attacks on our beachhead. Twenty two thousand live ones are cut off from Hirohito's help. Isolated in the Bougainville wilderness without supplies. Victory in the Solomons is complete. These wounded did not sacrifice in vain.
