In Stockholm was reached the agreement that considerably reduced the supply of ball -bearings to Germany. Stanton Griffis (left) representing the Federal Economic Administration, headed the U S delegation. He as was helped by Sir Victor Mallet British Minister to Sweden, Douglas Poteat of the Innierations Entermy, and Thilian Waring US Board of Economic Warfare, and William Waring for the British Government. At the Soviet Embassey the Griffis deputation was assured that Russia would bring pressure to bear of necessary. In Sweden the Soviet government is represented by Ambassadress Kalontay, the much valuable help. As Sweden is a neutral country, on Germany's doorstep, the negotiators had to tread lightly. In this natter the allies owe much to the Stanton Griffis mission.
