The attached newsreel taken in Stockholm may be of interest to you in connection with the ball-bearing negotiations.

The first scene shows Stanton Griffis, representing the Federal Economic Corporation, Douglas Poteat, representing the Board of Economic Warfare, London, and Mr. William Waring representing the British Ministry of Supply, coming out of Enskilda Bank in Stockholm with the signed ball-bearing agreements.

The second scene, taken on the same day, shows the American Minister, Mr. Hirshel Johnson, the British Minister, Sir Victor Mallet and Mr. Waring, coming out of the Russian Embassy after a conference with the Russian Ambassador, Mme. Kalontay.

The next scene shows Griffis and Poteat in conference with Mme. Kalontay on the ball-bearing matter, and the last scene shows Griffis and Poteat saying good-bye to Carl York on the roof of the Paramount Building, Stockholm.

This film might be of interest both in Great Britain and the United States, showing the action of the United Nations of the Swedish ball-bearing situation.
