CANADIAN SHIPS REACH PORT AFTER SINKING U-BOATS.

Steaming towards a British port, a flotilla of the Royal Canadian Navy bore good tidings of a successful battle with Nazi submarines. Though the U-Boat menace is a mere shadow of what it was, Nazi under-sea boats are still in the Atlantic, and the men-o-war of the Dominion keep constant watch on the life-lines of Great Britain. The scars of battle were many on His Majesty's Canadian ships as they moored at the quayside. No sooner were they tied up than the casualties of the action were brought ashore.

Much strengthened during the present war, the Royal Canadian Navy has played a gallant part in defeating the U-Boat menace.
