Landings in South Beveland and the neighbouring island of Walcheren, drove the germans foot by foot towards the sea and water defences and compelled their surrender.

Tilburg. ORESESSON SAN SAND LET XE TREMBAR V W W MOST

Something over the bombed railway bridge, soldiers who are now experts in this wet warfare gained the feoting on the north bank. "Weasels", invaluable in this territory and filmed here for the first time ferried more of our men across the canal towards the town.

Tilburg lies IN the base of the Arnhem salient in the sea flank. There was no fight for this town, from which the enemy retired to avoid being out off. Warm hearted Dutch tempfelk welcomed the townies as liberators.

Bron carriers bumped over the railway track between rilburg and Martoganbosch, a line still out by the enemy. Progress was alow. Wherever their right flank can be defended, the Germans could continue the fight till the position is hoppless.
