In Portsmouth for the first time since the invasion of France His Majesty was the guest of the Royal Navy. before inspecting Invasion day secrets the King spoke to a **Marine who was for many years a sailor on the Roya**l. yacht.

A hundred feet below ground His Majesty saw the big plotting table showing the invasion fleet positions **a** at **f**. 4.30 on the morning of D-Day, when W.R.F.N.S. plotted **b** the great seaborne assault. At the Royal Naval Barracks nearly four thousand sailors and wrens marched past, men and women who on D-Day, as always, earned the Nation's thanks.
