EXCERPTS FROM GERMAN NEWSREELS.

**Attempt on Hitler's life.** Shots of the room where the bomb was thrown. A few hours after the attempted assassination, Hitler greets Mussolini and Graziani. He confers with Himmler and then bids goodbye to Mussolini. Tannenberg. Funeral of General Korten, Chief of the Fuhrer's General Staff, killed in the attempt upon Hitler's life.

**Berlin.** Hitler visits in hospital various Nazi notables injured in the attempt upon his own life. The public show signs of delight at his escape. Hitler is congratulated by leading Nazi personalities, including Sperr, Himmler and Goebbels.

**Berlin.** Shots of Colonel Remer, Head of the Berlin Garrison who put down the attempted military rising timed to co-inside with the attempt upon Hitler's life.

**German Home Guard.** In the Army Region 11, all males irrespective of age, learn the use of firearms to take their place by the side of the Regular Army. The new organisation is known as the Landwacht.

**Russian Front:** To the commentator's explanation that the Germans are carrying out an orderly withdrawal, are shown shots of German troops moving back. Simultaneously infantry reserves advance towards the front line. Railways, bridges, etc. are destroyed. Pioneers lay mines along railway tracks. All buildings likely to assist military operations are burnt to the ground. Infantry safeguard the retreat.
