1.	Poplar makes the first move to provide temporary homes for the blitzed and are putting up hundreds of pre-fabricated huts which have a proposed life of at least 2 years. They are made from panels of asbestos sheet built of two sheets separated by a heat retaining composition of wood wool and cement. A squad of four men can erect one in a day although they weigh ten tons. They are all electric and will be rented for 10 shillings per week.
