U.S. NAVY MAULS JAPS OFF PHILIPPINES.

Admiral Nimitz reaped big gains when he sent a task force against heavily corted Jap conveys attempting to reinforce the Philippines. Fighter-bombers in great strongth, based on aircraft carriers, engaged the enemy in fights to the finish.

One Jap plane almost foll onto a U.S. Carrier.

U.J. battleships bombarded Manilla harbour. Recommaissance planes reported further enemy ships approaching and a powerful force of fighter-bombers took off.
