RED ARMY TAKE PRAGA, SUBURB OF WARSAW.

It was Zero Hour east of the Vistula. The dawn of a fine morning. In strength Russian armoured forces attacked Praga. With his staff directing operations was Colonel General Kazakov. Intense gun fire, bombarded targets in front of the tanks.

When the guns ceased fire the infantry advanced. By this time the outer defences of Praga were smashed. Visiting headquarters was one of the victors of Stalingrad, the popular Marshal Rokosovsky. By this time reports came in that tanks and infantry were already in the town. (after CU at phone) Polish regiments fighting with the Red Army were the first to march in the streets. Though the hoped for relief of Warsaw was not accomplished the Liberation of Praga foreshadowed the day when the enemy will be blasted from Polish soil..
