S.V. [Thirty years ago, I succeeded William Temple as Headmaster of Repton School. Now I am to succeed him as Archbishop of Canterbury. ^{lady} No-one can be what he was to the Church and to Christendom. All I can undertake, is to do my best with the help of God to serve our Church and people in this high office to which I have been called, an office rooted deep in our history and older than the Monarchy itself.]

C.C.U. [As I come to this office, may I say this to you:-

C.U. → [There are millions in this country who know in their hearts that what we need, as well as planning, and ~~so~~ much more than good intentions, is a return to faith in God and obedience to Him in our lives.] But though they know it, they do little about it. They are ready to talk about religion, and to criticize the Church - but ^{they} do not help it ^{or} allow it to help them.]

and C.U. [As I tackle my task, I ask them and you to tackle yours,

[A better ordering of society? Yes. ^{indeed} But that means better men and women, better in themselves and in their communal life. That can be, if we are loyal in heart and life to God,

know Him and serve Him: ^{but} not otherwise.] Say a prayer for me,

and for yourself, ^{and} for ^{of us} all. [Let us help one another to be up and doing in the fellowship of Christian Faith and Christian

action.]
