1.	<u>Reel 1. Silent material. The Working Kitchen.</u> Housewife in kitchen. Takes drying up cloth from special drying compartment. Dries cup and saucer and walks to hatch which connects with living room. Note new type blind.				
2.	<u>Dining Kitchen in a Flat.</u> Housewife with sister. She walks to gas frig -- lifts new typw folding plate rack over cooker -- then demonstrates griller which is now incorporated in oven. In next shot she is shown drawing boiling water from sink heater. This is new idea the sink heater giving warm-hot-and boiling water.				
3.	<u>Reel 2. Living Room Kitchen.</u> Family scene in the new living room kitchen. Various angles on this new set up where the kitchen is separated by a low partition which allows the housewife to keep an eye on the family whilst preparing the meal.				
4.	In close up she is seen looking in the latest type plastic cereal containers. Husband is seen one side of partition with children whilst the wife prepares the meal on other side.				
5.	<u>Reel 3. Eyemo.</u> <u>The small package kitchen.</u> Girl is seen placing plates in heating compartment below cooker. Then shows various food cabinets and enclosed sink heater.				
	<u>The back to back Kitchen-Bathroom Unit.</u> See notes !				
6.	<u>Reel 4. Eyemo.</u> Lord Woolton with Lady Woolton, kitchen demonstrator and Major Lloyd George in one of the Kitchens. This matches sound sequence. Exteriors of Dorland Hall.				
7.	<u>Reel 5. SOUND</u> Lord Woolton with Lady Woolton, one of the demonstrators and Major Lloyd George taking about the exhibition.
