DESCRIPTION : It was like a miniature D Day offensive this afternoon when the 11th. Arm. Div. pushed off ~~from the 4th. Inf. Div. sector~~ supported by elements of the ~~2nd. Inf. Reg.~~ and the Arm. Inf. Apparently this is a drive for the Rhine, and the weight of the attack should crush the enemy that resists.

Story. One Combat Command pushed off from Weinsheim, Germany, right behind the Infantry. The Infantry moved out in orderly fashion forming out, and advanced over the open plain toward the fortified woods. The Tanks followed up slowly while others poised on the line of departure and fired shells into the enemy gun positions. Seen in the field are two knocked out Tanks burning and a house used as an ammo. storage place is in full blaze. The attack started off smoothly while poised Armor waited to advance in waves.

The point at which the [redacted] Inf., Div., made contact with the British forces in the 9th Army's push to the Rhine. We see Doughboys of the [redacted] Inf., Regt., being greeted by Tommies of the [redacted] Field Co., (Royal Eng's.) 53rd Welsh Div., [redacted]. The GI's cross a foot-bridge with field equipment and lay it aside - the Tommies talk with them. They discuss their outfits and here are GI's of faces. There are scenes of the [redacted] Cav. Recon. Group - their m-8 armoured cars and jeeps being looked over by the British.

Geldern is held by the Tommies.

DESCRIPTION:

This morning, first hour, , crossed the Rhine at Remingen. The Germans had mined bridge and attempted to blow it but failed. Yank Engineers with utmost rapidity have set it right again. Without stopping our armoured vehicles and our doughfest cross bridge into Germany's heart.

Capture of Remingen had allowed Americans to capture several officers, ~~many of whom belonged to~~
