Naj, Spinder of the Luftwaffe talks to Daruall through interpreting dene by Ilex Clifford (Daily Mail) Presently Obest (Colonel) Kaseh, Chief of ground forces for the area sees the Air/Comm. who refuses to shake hands with the German. The rest is welcome scenes. It was virtually impossible to photograph as there were only eight in the party & we were mobbed in an amazing way. Had it not been for the German armed police guards we would have been pulled to pieces! Egerybody was armed but there was no shooting. This was the finest welcome that any Capital has given us. On our way back we saw the SHLEF Catalina and Sunderland painted white, coming in but they were too much underneath to photograph. This was the first British party to enter Norway.
