The rest are general festivity scenes of acclaiming the British and seeing the Germans start on their march back to Germany. These are lads of 15 and German WAAFS and nurses. Their transport hardly exists. The small tanks are French Renault, 2 men.

The rest is welcome scenes. It was virtually impossible to photograph as there were only eight in the party & we were mobbed in an amazing way. Had it not been for the German armed police guards we would have been pulled to pieces! Egerybody was armed but there was no shooting. This was the finest welcome that any Capital has given us. On our way back we saw the SHAEF Catalina and Sunderland painted white, coming in but they were too much underneath to photograph. This was the first British party to enter Norway.

He goes down to the harbour to look at some of the German shipping and then talks to the men of H.M.S. Dido" and H.M.S. BIRMINGHAM. The rest is the cheering crowds in the town. The largest crowds are in the Town Hall Square.

Also covered by: Cotter of Movietone at the ship. A.F.U. all over.
