Rolls 3 & 4;Field Marshal Gerd Von Rundstedt, captured by 7th Army 21st Corps, at a house for internment his son Lt Hans Gerd Von Rundstedt was taken also. 21st Corps C G deputy Gen F B Prickett accompanied the field Marshal.

DESCRIPTION : This morning men of Co. L 528th Reg, 26th (Yankee) Div, took this town of Mittenfels, capturing Field Marshall von Kleist in a house with his wife, invalid son, and his personal staff of orderlies. In another house was Brig. Gen. Russwurm, in charge of all the Signal Troops in the German Army. Von Kleist is the General who was in charge of the entire Polish campaign in 1939. These pictures were taken as the Generals were put in cars at Mittenfels to be sent back to the rear. By order of Gen. Paul, CG of the Div, these were the only pictures that we were allowed to take, as the captives entered the vehicles. He also ordered that no Amc cars were to be photographed in the same shots. The American seen is Lt. Col. John Cotter, Lynn, Mass, Assis. Chief of Staff, and ~~head of 328~~, 26th Div.

ROLL 1 MLS as von Kleist leaves building. MS as he enters Staff car. CU in car. MCU of Gen. Russwurm on left, and Gen. Von Kleist talking. Von Kleist carries a Marshall's baton. CU of Von Kleist. MLS pan as car with Von Kleist drives away for the rear, with U.P. escort.

Note: Light was poor in spots - particularly interior shots in car. Exposed at F.28.

(It is said that Von Kleist is the Gen. who cracked the French Maginot Line. Would you check please.)

Almost on the Danish Border stands the town of Flensburg, the present H.Q. of the German High Command. Grand Admiral Doenitz refused to pose for a picture but on leaving his H.Q. for lunch, it was possible to obtain a very brief coverage on him. The shots taken after these of the new "FUEHRER" are brief scenes showing what is occurring in the immediate vicinity of the H.Q. and are intended as a small build-up. Owing to camera trouble it was not possible to do more.

German High Command H.Q. with armed sentries at the door. Grand Admiral Doenitz comes out, enters car and drives away. C.U. of the entrance and armed guards.

The immediate entrance to the H.Q. area is guarded by Armed Germans who check vehicles at a road block.

A short distance away at the German-Danish border, German troops, all armed, are marching back into Germany in their thousands under the eyes of the Danish patriots.
